POINTS TO REMEMBER:

1. If you are applying to a UC campus, you must take SAT or ACT plus writing, and two SAT subject tests in two different subject areas. CSU applications can be sent now!
2. Take the SAT or ACT as soon as possible and by Dec. 08 for 4-year colleges.
3. You may be eligible for a fee waiver for SAT, ACT, and college applications---check with your counselor or Kris Caldwell.
4. Pick up letter of recommendation forms in Counseling Center...now!!
5. Free scholarship searches are available online. Try signing up at www.fastweb.com. An email address is required.
6. Be sure you copy (or print a copy of) everything that you send to colleges.
7. Get "Proof of Mailing" at the post office if you send materials to colleges such as application forms, financial aid forms and grade verification forms.
8. Write (email) or call private and out of state schools for applications or check online.
