1. **SunTrust Off To College Scholarship Sweepstakes** \$1000 awarded every two weeks from Oct 31, 2008 through May 15, 2009: www.offtocollege.info for more information. SunTrust is a bank that offers education loans. Check with your parent before signing up for the scholarship drawings.

2. **CSU Chico Music Department and Department of Theatre Arts:** There are auditions for scholarships. CSU Theatre Arts offers a Bachelor of Arts in Theatre Arts and a B.A. in Musical Theatre. www.csuchico.edu

3. **American Legion Financial Aid Handbook** is available to check out. www.needalift.org

4. **California Native Plant Society Scholarship** of \$1500, for student entering a bachelor's program with a life science major, due: April 3.

5. **McConnell Foundation Scholarship** Two programs are available through the McConnell Foundation: TMF Scholars, and TMF Vista. 6. **Order Sons of Italy in America** Offers scholarships in academics, sports, and Italian Language Study Grants. Must be wholly or partially of Italian descent, and must enroll in college or trade school fall 2009. www.sonsofitalyca.org, due 3/1/09.

7. **The Art Institutes** offer scholarships for Design, Fashion, Culinary Arts, and other. www.artinstitutes.edu with varying deadlines.

8. **Shasta College Scholarships** include the following: **The Caterpillar/Peterson Scholarship** for student enrolling in their Diesel Technology Program; **The Shasta College Management Team Scholarship** for student with 3.0 GPA, leadership, academic

excellence, good citizenship; **The Shasta College McConnell Scholar Award** requires 3.0 GPA; **The Shasta Symphony Scholarship** for a Music Major with acceptance into the Shasta Symphony; **The John F. and Detta Nielsen Memorial Mechanics Scholarship** for student enrolling in the Heavy duty Mechanics Program; and the **Vanderwerf-Vargas Scholarship** requiring financial need, community involvement. All applications are due: March 3rd.

9. Janice M. Scott Memorial Scholarship Fund 2.5 GPA or higher, attend 4 yr college Fall 2009, leadership abilities, essay "What Do Freedom and Justice Mean" to applicant. Applications are in the Counseling Center.

10. Martin G. Tillman Memorial Scholarship Recipient is chosen by the family, GPA of 3.0 or higher, participant in school and community activities. 2009 applications will arrive in early spring; deadline is the last Friday in April.

11. EETA Dee Ann Dobonye Memorial Scholarship for students entering the teaching profession. Applicant must have attended an Enterprise Elementary school, and minimum of 3.0 GPA in high school.

12. RMHC Scholarship Program includes four separate scholarships: RMHC Asia, RMHC African American, RMHC Hispanic American, and RMHC Scholars. Deadline to submit application is Feb. 16th. Applications are at www.rmhc.org or in the Counseling Center.

13. eQuality Scholarship recognizes service to the lesbian/gay/bisexual/transgender community. Applications and info at www.equalityscholarship.org. Deadline is February 21. Ten awards of \$5000.

14. Balanced Man Scholarship for outstanding males entering CSU Sacramento. Applications are in the Counseling Center.

15. Military Order Of The Purple Heart offers \$1000 scholarship to direct descendants of a Veteran, 3.0 GPA, financial need, requires an essay. Due: April 3.

16. Scott Valley Bank Scholarship recipient must have demonstrated interest in business or finance and attend Shasta College this fall. This scholarship pays for books, tuition, and fees for full-time student. Deadline: April 17th.

17. Civil Service Employees Insurance Company's Youth Automobile Safety Scholarship for children of full-time public employee, 3.0 GPA, essay required. Due to them: April 6'

18. Redding Grange #446 offers a scholarship, w/minimum high school GPA of 3.25, written statement about your community activities, and statement regarding future goals. Grange affiliation is not required. Deadline is April 1st.
