Free COVID-19 Testing for EHS Students on Modified Quarantine

Hello! We will be offering a modified quarantine option for students who have had a classroom exposure to COVID-19 and are identified as a "close contact" through contact tracing. Students on modified quarantine are eligible to remain in school during quarantine as long as they are symptom-free and test negative for COVID-19 twice a week. We will be offering free COVID-19 antigen tests for students in modified quarantine on Tuesday and Friday mornings. If you would like your child to be eligible for testing on campus, you must pre-register. Please click on the Primary Health link below to register. Only students who have pre-registered and completed the consent documentation prior to the time of exposure will be eligible for testing on campus.

This is a service we are offering for students who would like to participate in modified quarantine. No students will be required to test.

SUHSD has partnered with the California Department of Public Health to offer COVID-19 testing. This testing is through Primary Health and begins on 11/2/2021. To get started, click this link <u>https://my.primary.health/l/shasta-union</u>. You only need to register once per student.

Here is some basic information about the testing program:

- Testing twice weekly is required for students to remain on campus during modified quarantine.
- This program offers rapid antigen testing: BinaxNOW (Testing takes less than 5 minutes and results are available in under 30-minutes).
- Pre-registration is required and collects necessary information and consent.
- All questions included in registration are required for California State Public Health reporting. Please note this program is free for all participants.
- Information and test results are only shared with the testing site, lab partners, and local/state health departments. It is not used for any other purposes.
- All results are shared electronically with the contact information provided during registration.

We will be testing on Tuesdays and Fridays at EHS between 8:15 – 9:15 am in Room 21 adjacent to the South parking lot.
