To the Parents/Guardians of students at Enterprise High School:

Our goal at Enterprise High School is to provide a quality education – and more specifically – to continue to give your sons or daughters the knowledge, skills, confidence to succeed, and most importantly a hopeful outlook on their future. Our faculty will continue to focus on two areas: Planning curriculum & instruction, and assessment strategies. In recent years, since the Enactment of the Public Schools Accountability Act, it has become increasingly more important to align school curriculum with State Standards so our students may demonstrate proficiency in each of their classes.

The purpose of this letter is to inform you that Enterprise High School has been identified as a Year 1 *Program Improvement* (PI) school under the Federal *No Child Left Behind* (NCLB) Act of 2001. The reason for this identification is that our school is required to meet Adequate Yearly Progress (AYP). At this time we did not achieve AYP for two consecutive years [2009-10, 2010-11]. The AYP area(s) that caused the identification are: English-Language Arts & Mathematics. The California High School Exit Exam (CAHSEE) administered annually to sophomores requires a percentage of students score above 380 to be considered “proficient” in English Language Arts and Mathematics. A score of 350 are required for passing the CAHSEE.

All parents/guardians of students attending a PI school have the right to request a transfer of their children to a non-PI district school with district-paid transportation. If you need additional assistance or have questions about transferring to another SUHSD school, please contact the school principal or Kyle Turner at 241-3261.
