



## Cell Phone, Electronic devices & Dress Code Policies

- Cell phone/electronic and musical devices may not be used in any classroom at any time, unless being used for teacher-directed academic purposes.
- No cell phones or musical devices may be used running errands during class time (i.e. trips to the restroom, office, media center, etc...)
- Cell phones or musical devices that are visible or heard ringing, vibrating, etc. during class time hours in or out of a classroom will be confiscated.
- Cell phones or musical devices use is defined as: phone calls, texting, emailing, surfing the web, checking the time, calling mom or dad, listening to music, etc. (etc. equals everything else).

### Violations will result in the following:

- 1<sup>st</sup> infraction:** Device is confiscated and returned to the student at the end of the school day, and the policy is reviewed with the student.
- 2<sup>nd</sup> infraction:** Device is confiscated, parent is required to pick up device, and the policy is reviewed with parent.
- 3<sup>rd</sup> infraction:** Device is confiscated, parent is required to pick up the device, and student will be assigned one day of lunch detention and campus beautification.
- 4<sup>th</sup> infraction:** Device is confiscated, parent is required to pick up the device, policy is reviewed with parent and student, and student will be assigned two days of lunch detention and campus beautification.
- 5<sup>th</sup> and subsequent infractions:** Device is confiscated, parent is required to pick up the device, policy is reviewed with parent and student, and student receives one or more days of ISS, and possible SARB referral process begins.

**\*All devices may be picked up by the student at the end of the school day on Friday of that week.**

## Dress Code Policy

- ALL clothing shall be neat, clean, and free from excessive holes and tears.
- Cut-off jeans and “short-shorts” are not allowed.
- Hats and/or head coverings are not allowed on campus during school hours.
- No costumes will be worn except on “dress-up” days arranged by ASB.
- Shorts shall be an appropriate length and not distracting.
- Tops shall have straps that cover a bra-strap, cover the mid-section, sides, and back of the upper torso.
- Appropriate undergarments must be worn when wearing see-through clothing.

### Violations will result in the following:

- 1<sup>st</sup> infraction:** Dress code policy will be discussed and student will be required to change.
- 2<sup>nd</sup> infraction:** Dress code policy will be discussed, student will be required to change, and parents will be contacted.
- 3<sup>rd</sup> infraction:** Dress code policy will be discussed, student will be required to change, parents will be contacted, and student will be assigned one lunch detention and campus beautification.
- 4<sup>th</sup> and subsequent infractions:** Dress code policy will be discussed, student will be required to change, parents will be contacted, and two or more lunch detentions and campus beautifications will be assigned.
