

Tardy Policy 2021-22

Working together this plan should have a positive impact on our students' timeliness to class this year. The introduction of teacher supervised lunch detentions is a significant addition to our handling of student tardiness. Teachers are encouraged to engage students regarding the importance of punctuality early and often especially after first and second tardy. Phone calls home are also helpful.

1. **1st-4th tardies**: teachers assign a class consequence, i.e. conversation, call home, tardy paragraph etc.
2. **5th tardy**: teacher supervised detention.
3. **6th tardy**: teacher assigned consequence.
4. **7th tardy**: 2 teacher supervised detention.
5. **8th tardy**: teacher assigned consequence.
6. **9th tardy**: Saturday School
7. **10+ tardies**: Contact with parent/guardian and possible meeting

Teacher supervised detentions will be held in the theatre.

A Google doc will be created by the TOA recording students that are assigned to teacher supervised detention.

Teachers need to bring their own electronic device to record attendance by the end of the lunch period.

Key to the theatre will be in Rm 31 and must be picked up and returned by the teacher on duty during lunch.

The teacher supervised detention is for the **TOA ONLY** to assign. Teachers may not assign this as a consequence.

NO electronics, earbuds, chromebooks to be used during detention
